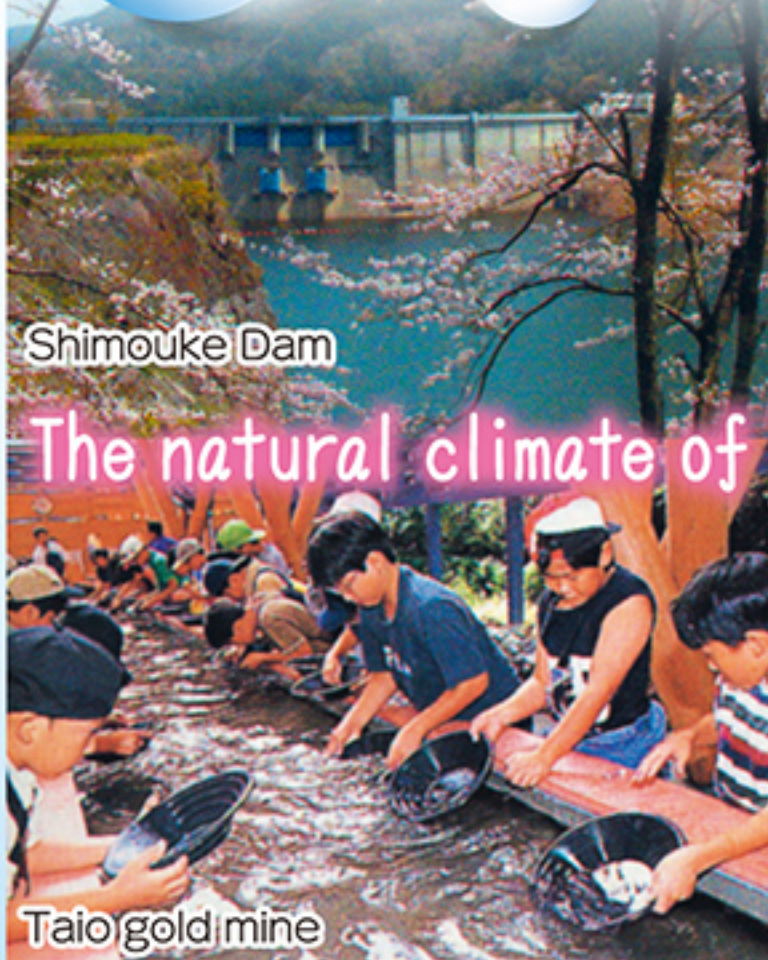
What is "Riverside station"?

It is a facility near the river or related to the activity of the river. It is a space facility that provides visitors with toilets, rest areas, information about the area, and promotes encounters and communication between visitors and residences.

Riverside Stations where people and culture encounter

The riverside was once the center of the area, and the riverside liveliness was the center of exchange. Now again, the movement to reorganize the riverside as the center of the area is going to be heightened. In the country, interchange bases such as Roadside Stations, Sea Stations, River Stations and Town Stations appear. There are approximately 1,145 Roadside Stations as of April 2018, 167 of Sea Stations as of July 2018, and 1,710 Town Stations as of September 2018. And these collaborations, networks are expected. Although "Riverside Station" is going to spread throughout the country as a place of exchange of people of the riverside, the system design at the national level and the development organization are not yet developed. The "Riverside Station" is located along the river regardless of the administration style of the citizens, and it is a facility with various functions such as resting, making of bustle, environment, education, health, sightseeing, disaster prevention measures depending on the installation location.

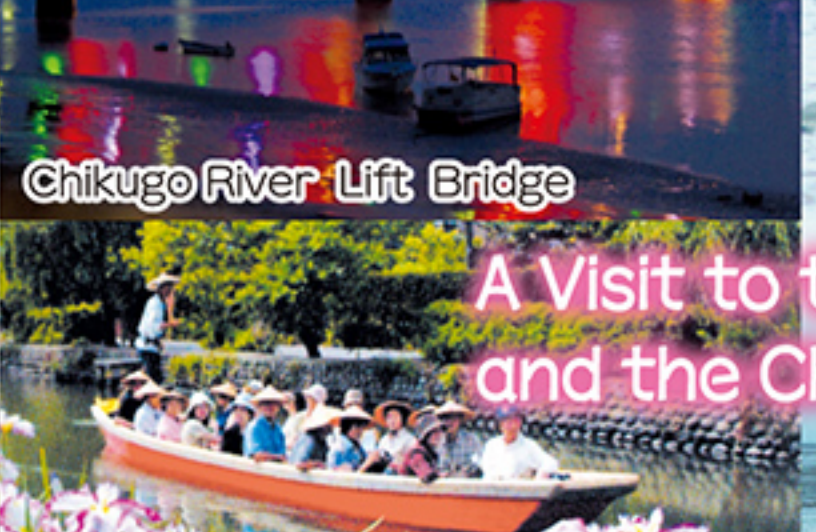

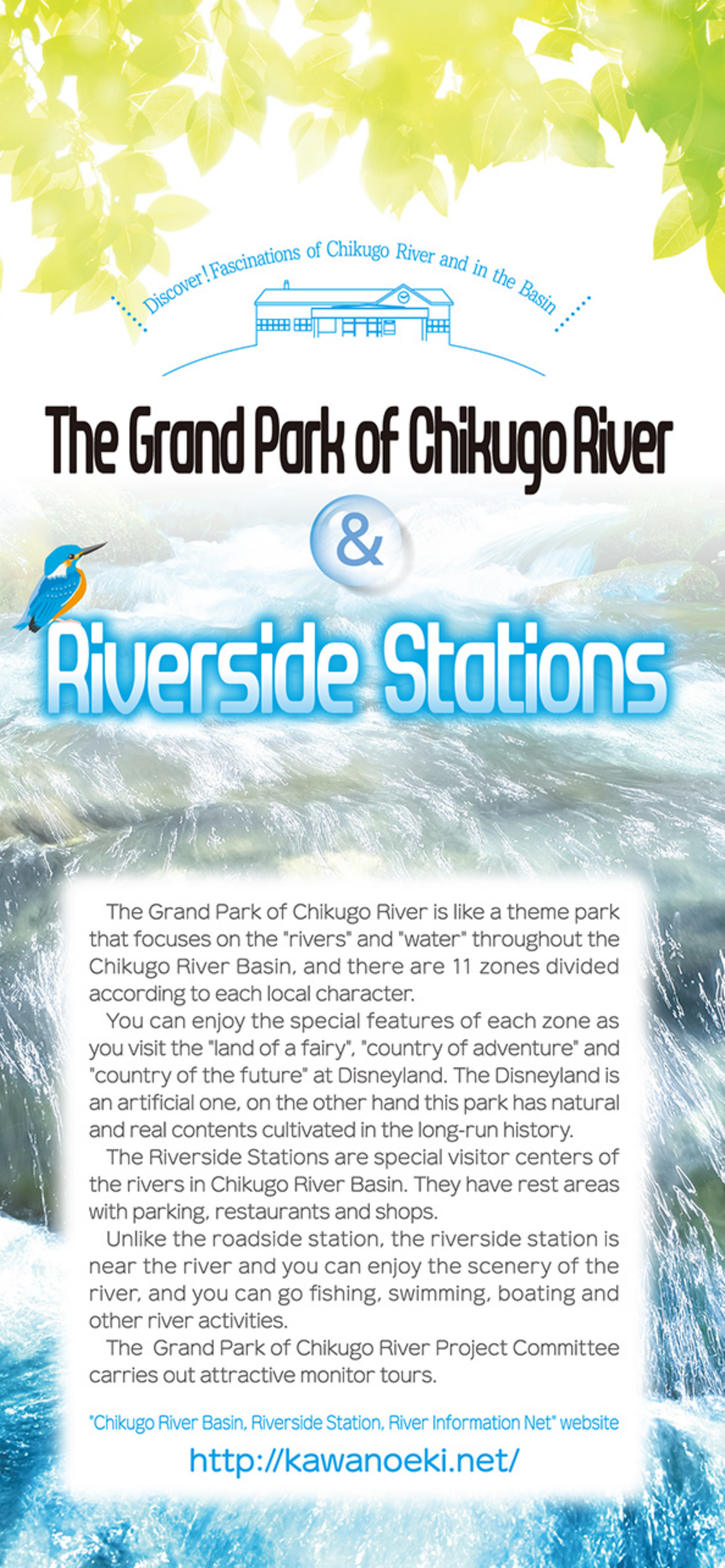

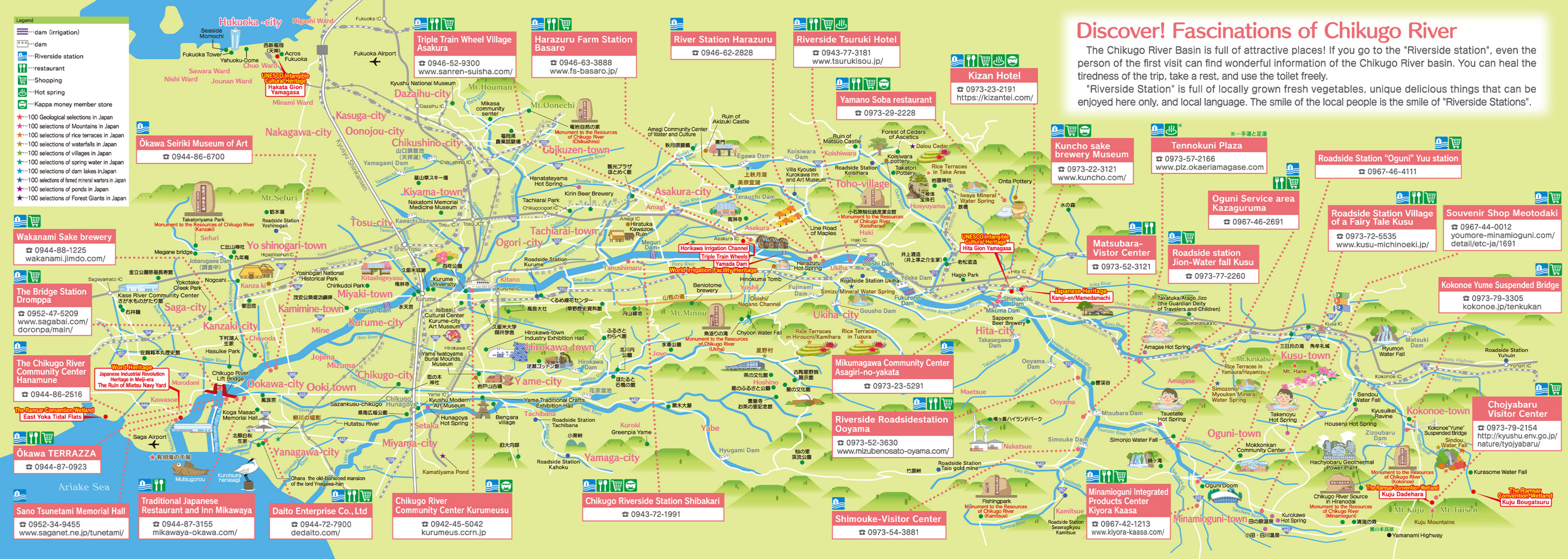
